

WMLC Severe Weather Policy

FALL, WINTER, AND SPRING TERMS:

When severe weather is likely: <u>on weekdays</u>, the Therapeutic Recreation Coordinator will begin to monitor the following online resources at noon and continue to check periodically until 1:00pm for the conditions listed below*.

<u>On Saturdays</u>, decisions can be made on Friday, otherwise no alterations should be made to group schedules or therapeutic recreation before the day of activity.

If the conditions below* are forecasted to coincide with the time of any social skills group or other activities, the Therapeutic Recreation Coordinator will notify the Director of Programming or the Executive Director by 1:00pm. Whichever party is notified will consult with the other to determine which course of action to take.


SUMMER TERM:

When severe weather is likely the Therapeutic Recreation Coordinator will monitor the following online resources throughout the day for the conditions listed below*. Clients participating in afternoon activities (1:00pm on) will be notified by 11:00am the day of the activity if cancellations are necessary.

If the conditions below* are forecasted to coincide with the time of any social skills group, therapeutic recreation, or other activity, the Therapeutic Recreation Coordinator will notify the Director of Programming or the Executive Director. Whichever party is notified will consult with the other to determine which course of action to take.

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ALL TERMS:

In most cases, there will be a decision to either cancel everything or nothing. If the following conditions exist, the decision may be to proceed with groups, but to use a preapproved alternate activity at the center or another indoor location in lieu of scheduled outings:

- Wind Chill Advisory/cold weather (If actual temperature or wind chill are -10 or colder)
- Severe Thunderstorm Warning (If lightning may interfere with outdoor activity plans)
- Heat Index Warning Extreme Caution Level

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All original scheduled activities will proceed under the following weather conditions:

- Light to Moderate Precipitation (e.g., a light mist or drizzle, light to moderate rain, light to moderate snow fall)
- Thunderstorms without the presence of Severe Weather Warnings (indoor activities only)
- Heat Advisory Warnings Caution

If the above mentioned weather conditions occur during an activity WMLC staff will use their discretion to direct clients in exercises to ensure comfort (e.g., frequent indoor warming breaks, frequent water breaks, etc.).

Closures of activity locations will impact the decision regarding activity cancelation and/or alteration. WMLC will follow weather/ground condition policies of the establishments in question.

Regular staff already in the office will work their scheduled hours, unless they receive a dismissal from the Executive Director.

WCCO and KARE11 will be notified of any decisions to close. Clients and staff may sign up for email notification from WCCO and/or KARE11 if they choose.
